Essential Qualifications for faculty for M.P.Ed.

The minimum qualifications required for the post of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor are as per the UGC norms which are as under:

Eligibility Conditions:

The minimum qualifications required for the post of Professors / Associate Professors / Assistant Professors are as per the UGC / AICTE norms which are as under:

(A) Professors

- i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college, and/or experience in research at the University/National level institutions/ industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process.
- iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS).

OR

An outstanding professional, with an exceptional accomplishment established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/ allied/ relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

(B) Associate Professor

- i) Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/ relevant disciplines.
- ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- iv) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students, as evidenced by Ph.D. thesis/co-authored books/publications in peer reviewed journals.
- v) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS).

(C) Assistant Professor

- i) Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR.
- iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in (ii) above candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET.
- iv) NET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET is not conducted.
- v) A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. degree holders, who have passed their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991.
- vi) Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university shall also be considered eligible.

Essential Qualifications for faculty for B.A.B.Ed & B.Sc.B.Ed (Integrated Programmes)

A. Perspectives in Education or Foundation courses

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Social Sciences with minimum 55% marks; and
- (ii) M.Ed. degree from a recognized university with minimum 55% marks.
or
- (iii) Postgraduate (MA) degree in Education with minimum 55% marks; and B.Ed. degree with minimum 55% marks.

B. Curriculum and Pedagogic Courses

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Sciences/Mathematics/Social Sciences/Languages with minimum 55% marks, and
- (ii) M.Ed. degree with minimum 55% marks.
Desirable: PhD. in Education with pedagogic specialization.

[Note: In case of A and B put together, for two faculty positions, a postgraduate degree in Sociology/Psychology/Philosophy with 55% marks and B.Ed./BEIEd with 55% marks and three years of teaching experience in a secondary school shall be considered.]

C. Specialized Courses

Physical Education

- (i) Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.) with minimum 55% marks.

Visual Arts

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Fine Arts (MFA) with minimum 55% marks

Performing Arts

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Music/Dance/Theatre Arts with minimum 55% marks.

Instructions for applicants:

1. The candidates are required to apply on prescribed form latest by April 21, 2017.
2. Qualifications, pay scales & other conditions etc. can be changed by the Management, if so desires. Number of posts advertised.
3. The prescribed qualification and experience will be minimum, and the mere fact that a candidate possessing the same will not entitle him/her to be called for interview.
4. The University will have the right to restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview, based on the recommendations of the Screening Committee constituted as per the Regulations for this purpose, to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed or by any other condition that it may deem fit.
5. Remuneration payable shall be commensurate to qualification & experience.
6. Retired/In-service experienced faculty on deputation/lien from reputed institutions shall also be considered.
