(a) DOODLING

- Individual event.
- The theme of the event is “Shades of Life”.
- Participants will have to complete the work of art within one hour. Each participant must be filmed (without cuts) on camera/mobile camera while doodling. The video along with the art work will be considered to ensure that the work is completed within the time limit of one hour.
- Only A4 size sheet is allowed to be used.
- The work can be colourful or black and white.

(b) POSTER MAKING

- Individual event.

- Participants will have to complete the work of art within one hour. Each participant must be filmed (without cuts) on camera/mobile camera while drawing. The video along with the art work will be considered to ensure that the work is completed within the time limit of one hour.

(a) KAVITA KUNJ

- Recite any short poem (a self-composed poem or someone else's poem) and the recital should be recorded on camera/mobile camera.
- The duration of the video should be between 3 and 5 minutes.
- One participant can submit only one entry.
- The poem can be in Hindi/ English/ Punjabi.
- The video must not contain special effects or background music.
- It must be made clear in the introduction whether the poem has been written by the participant or someone else. Plagiarism can lead to disqualification. The authorship of the poem will not be considered in judgement.
- Introduction to the poem and poet should be made in the beginning. It shouldn't exceed 30 seconds.

(b) ENVISAGE: SCRIBBLE YOUR WORLD

- This is a story writing competition. Maximum word limit: 500.
- The mixing of languages will lead to disqualification.
- The story should be focused on the theme of "The Old Age".
- Language can be English/Punjabi/Hindi.

(c) ELOCUTION

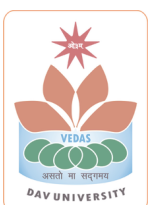
- The topic for elocution is "Never Quit".
- The speech should not exceed 5 minutes.
- Each speaker is expected to memorize their speech and is not allowed to read any part of the speech from papers, notes or cards.
- Language can be English/Punjabi/Hindi.
- The mixing of languages can lead to disqualification.
- Points will be awarded on the basis of the following criteria:
 - Greeting and Introduction to the subject.
 - Exposition of the main theme (conciseness & clarity of message, originality/points of interest, due mention of references).
 - Moral and practical application.
 - Memorization.
 - Verbal clarity.
 - Presentation/style.
 - Grammar of the language chosen.
