

EVENTS- RULES FOR PARTICIPATION

Debate competition – 23-03-2023

Theme: Impact of Science and Technology on Environment

Rules:

- 2 members per team, 1 for and 2 against the motion.
- Time allowed – 2+2 minutes to express their views and 1 minute for interjection.
- All statements must accompany reasons or evidence in support.
- No cross questioning; language no bar; paper reading and use of electronic media will deduct marks.
- Offensive, personal and derogatory comments will lead to disqualification.

Quiz competition – 23-03-2023

Rules:

- One team with maximum 3 participants.
- Question medium – English only.
- There will be preliminary screening round, only top 5 qualified teams will participate in final quiz.
- Use of printed material and electronic gadgets will not be allowed.
- Scores from all rounds will contribute to final scores.
- Time limit of each round will be there.
- All the rights related with the competition are reserved to Organizers only.

Rangoli competition – 24-03-2023

Theme: Theme: Life Style for Environment

Rules:

- Only 2 participants per team allowed.
- Participants will have to bring their own material. Only eco-friendly materials like stones, grains, flower petals, leaves, grass, stems/twigs, lentils, sand, Rangoli colors (powdered/sand based), etc. can be used for making rangoli.
- Maximum size allowed – 3 ft x 3 ft.
- Use of stencils or other aids will lead to disqualification.
- Time allowed will be 2 hours.

Photography Competition – 24-03-2023

Theme: Explore Nature Through My Eyes

Rules:

- Only 1 entry per participant in JPG/JPEG format only.
- Caption necessary, images from mobile camera with highest possible resolution will be accepted.
- Entry is limited to original works for which the entrant holds all applicable rights.
- Digitally altered photographs beyond standard optimization will be disqualified.
- Images with mixing i.e. merging two or more images or deleting contents of images will be disqualified.
- Watermarked entries will not be accepted.
- Objectionable material of any kind will not be entertained.
- All disputes shall be resolved at the entrant level only.

Entry to all the events is free

Model Display Competition – 24-03-2023

Theme: Science and Technology

Rules:

- Each team will consist of maximum 2 participants.
- A non-working or working model along with self-explanatory poster should be presented at the event.
- The model should be related to theme of the event.
- Participants can choose any material of their choice.
- Model should be selfmade.

Slogan Writing Competition – 24-03-2023

Theme: Lifestyle for Environment

Rules:

- One participant can register only once.
- The slogan must reflect the core theme- 'Lifestyle for environment'
- Language can be English/Hindi/Punjabi.
- Word limit – 5 to 25 words.
- Slogans should be short, crisp and catchy.
- Slogans should be original and use of foul language must be avoided in all circumstances.

Poster Presentation– 24-03-2023

Theme: Climate Justice

Rules:

- 2 Participants and one poster per team.
- Size – 18" x 24"
- Official language – English.
- Poster must be readable from at least 2 ft away.
- Handmade posters only.

Painting Competition – 24-03-2023

Theme: Beat Plastic Pollution

Rules:

- One participant can register only once.
- Drawing sheet will be provided by university.
- Participants will bring their own colours.
- No reference material will be allowed.
- Stencils will not be allowed to decorate painting.
- Time allowed – 2 hours.

Best Out of Waste Competition – 24-03-2023

Rules:

- 2 participants per team.
- The exhibit will be rejected if not found made of waste or second hand material.
- No ready or semi-finished model or matter would be accepted from participant in competition.

Digital Poster on Millet Awareness – 24-03-2023

Rules:

- The finished posters are 8.5 X 11 inches (300 DPI) in size, landscape layout. The design specifics are the following: TIFF, JPG, PSD.
- Poster containing clip art or downloaded designs will be rejected.
- 2 participants per team.
- 2 hours allowed to complete the poster.
- Explanation of the work will be expected.
