

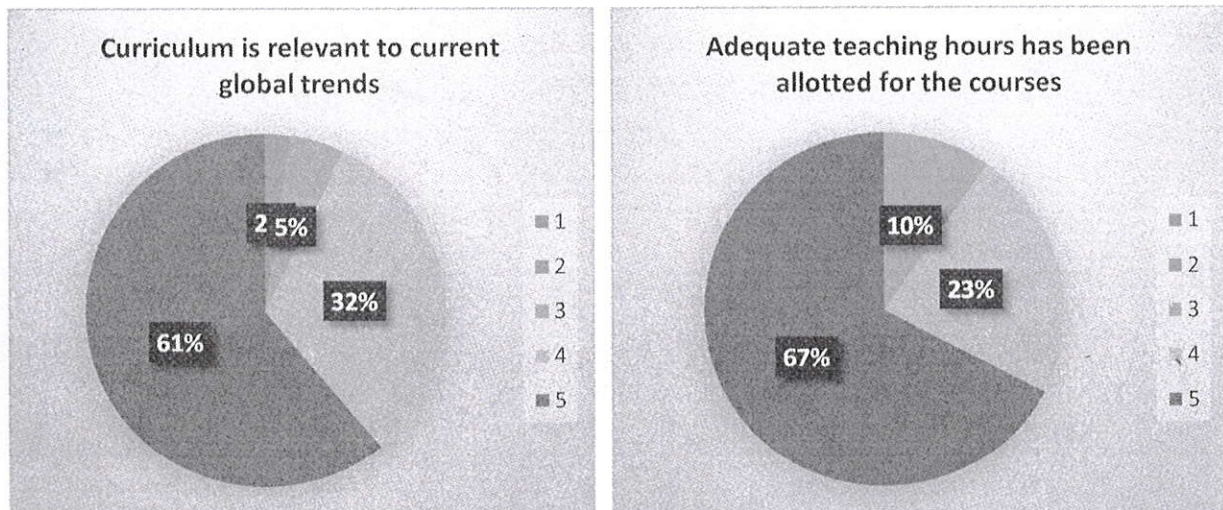


Feedback analysis report for the feedback taken from the students for the session 2023-24

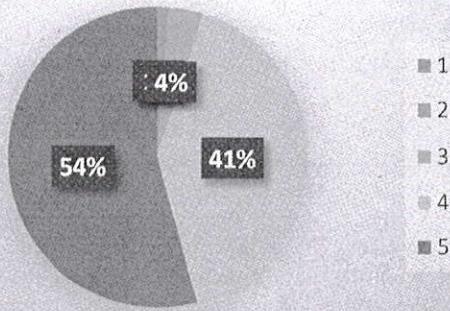
A feedback of students was taken on curriculum in which a total of 2203 students participated and gave their response. The students gave their responses on the following questions:

2. Adequate teaching hours has been allotted for the courses
3. Practical content is in congruence to the theory content of the respective course
4. Practical content is hands on for higher technical skilling
5. Online resources relevant to curriculum are accessible
6. Curriculum has played strong role in student development
7. Assigned teacher has good knowledge about the subject
8. Curriculum enhances analysing and problem solving skills
9. Course outcomes and curriculum scheme are well aligned
10. University positively considers student feedback for curriculum development

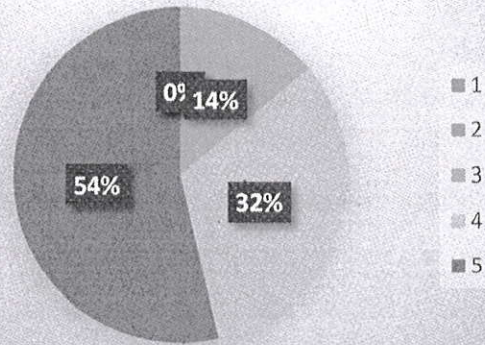

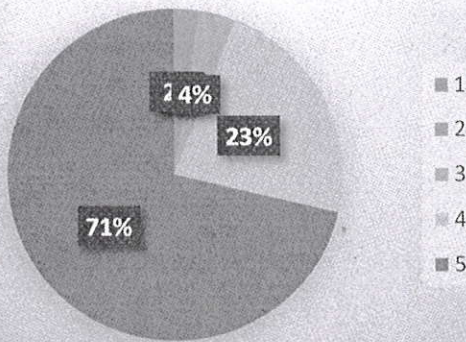
Practical content is in congruence to the theory content of the respective course



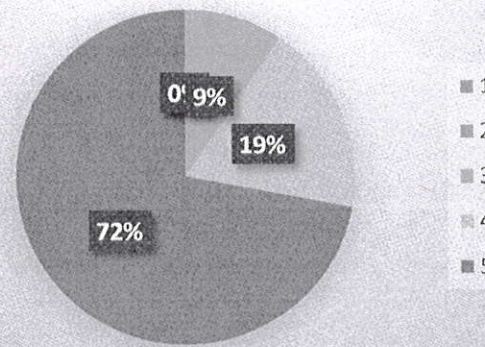
Practical content is hands on for higher technical skilling



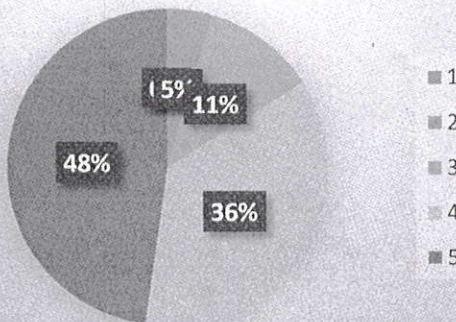
Online resources relevant to curriculum are accessible



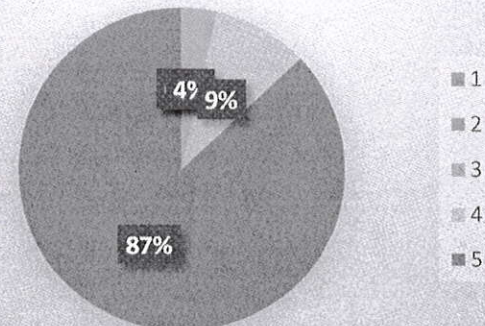
Curriculum has played strong role in student development

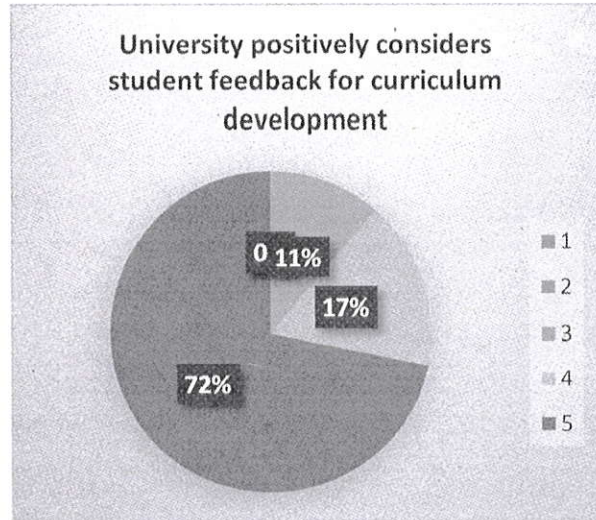
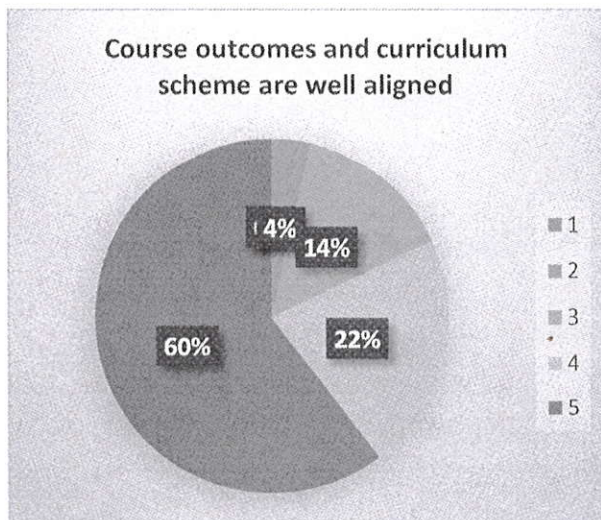


Assigned teacher has good knowledge about the subject

Analysis of the feedback:

- Almost 87% of the students were satisfied with the acquisition of problem solving skills from the curriculum studied by them where as a small percentage rating it lower.
- 72% of the participating students believed that their development is actively influenced by the curriculum.
- Almost 90% of the participating students believed that university takes the students feedback positively and duly considers it in the development of curriculum.
- Availability of relevant online resources: 71% rated this highly, indicating satisfaction with online resources.
- Adequacy of teaching hours: 67% of students rated this as 5, showing that most feel the teaching hours are sufficient.

Action Taken Report on Feedback:

Positive Actions:

- **Enhanced curriculum for problem-solving:** This strong performance will be maintained and enhanced by further integrating analytical tasks into assessments.
- **Focus on student development:** The strong role of the curriculum in development is clear. We will continue to align learning outcomes with career readiness and personal growth.
- **Online Resources:** Students have shown satisfaction with online resources, so we will ensure these are continuously updated to remain relevant.

Areas for Improvement:

- **Feedback Clarification:** There are some issues with unclear or missing data for certain feedback questions. We will review the survey design and ensure better clarity in future surveys.
- **Addressing Mixed Feedback:** For areas where feedback is not strongly positive or negative, further investigation is needed. We will conduct follow-up surveys or focus group discussions to understand and address student concerns more deeply.
