



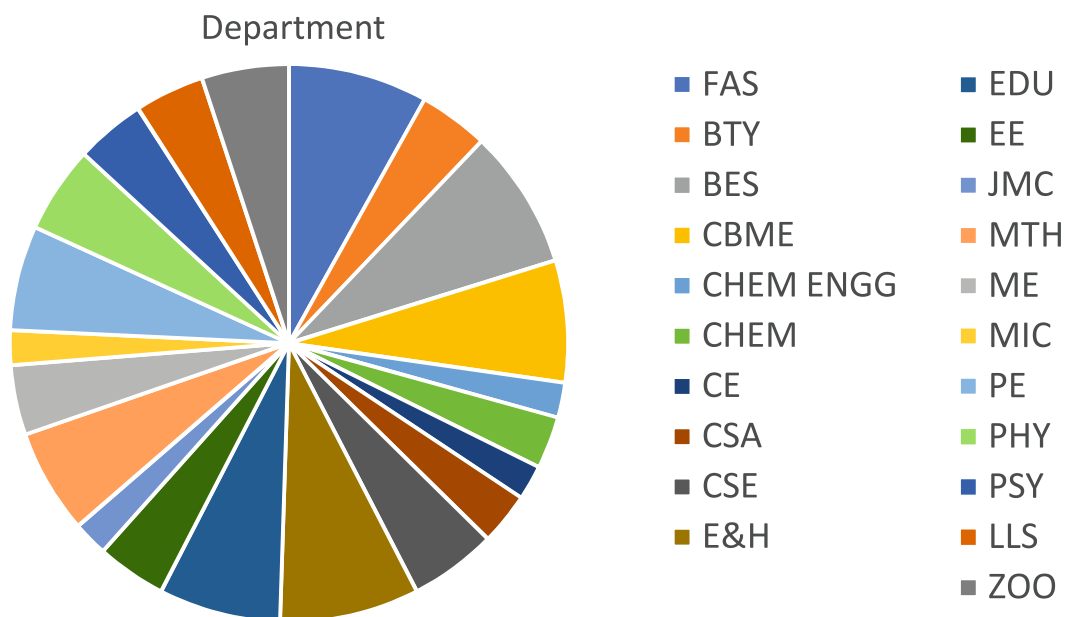

STUDENT FEEDBACK REPORT:

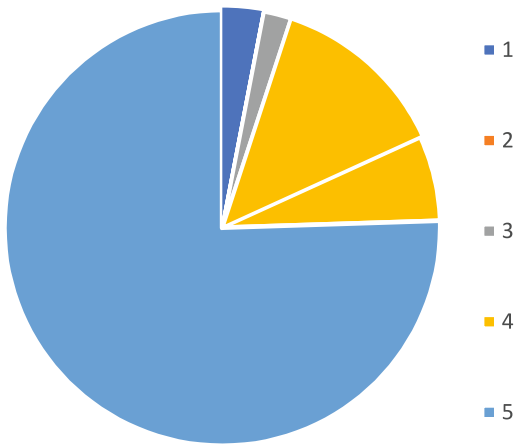

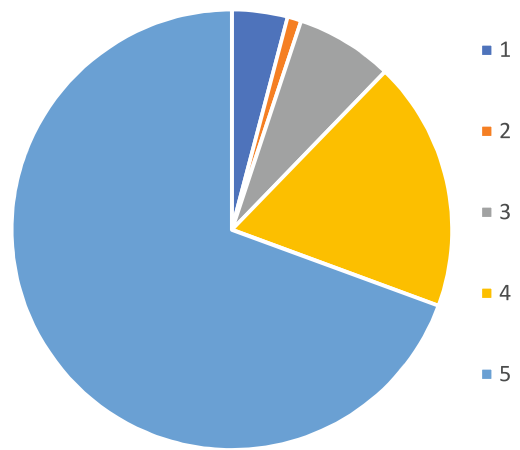
Parents/guardians were encouraged to participate in the process in an unbiased manner.

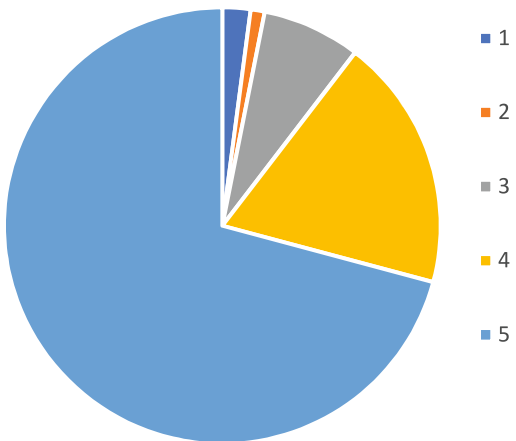
Q1: Extra-curricular development is encouraged on campus .



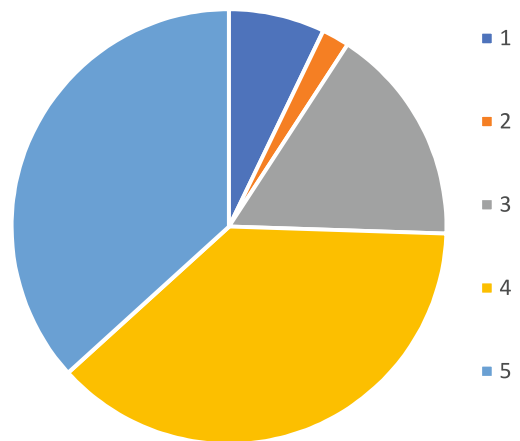
Q2: Curriculum is relevant to the current societal needs



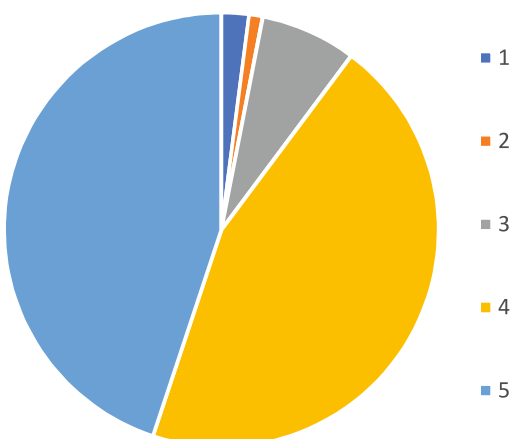
Q3: Academic infrastructure is adequate



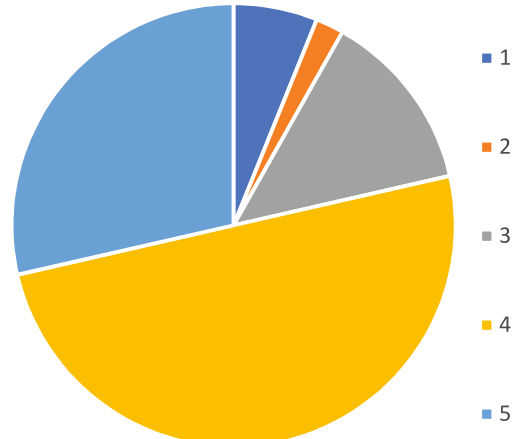
Q4: Students are treated without any prejudice



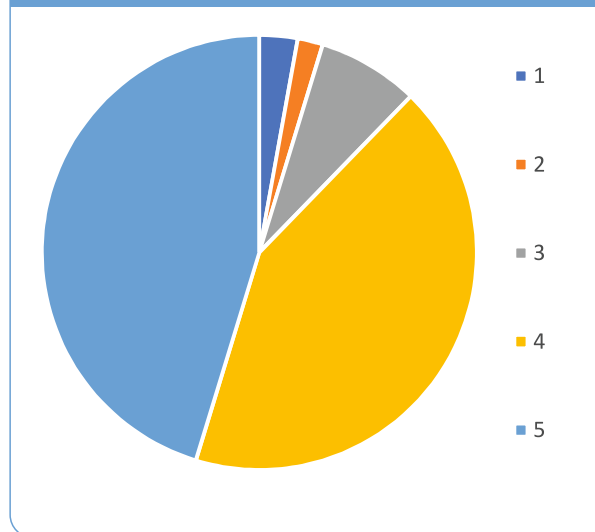
Q5: University's social engagements are optimum for student development.
