**Objective:** To enhance students' counseling skills through practical experience by providing individual and group therapy to inmates at Bolster Treatment and Rehabilitation Centre.

**Detail of Activity:**

The Department of Psychology at DAV University, Jalandhar organized an educational visit to **Bolster Treatment and Rehabilitation Centre on 12<sup>th</sup> September 2018**. As a part of the voluntary Consultancy services of the department, the students regularly visited the Bolster Rehabilitation Centre, Jalandhar, throughout the academic session, to hone their counseling skills. This was done with individual and group therapy providing psychological interventions for the inmates at the centre. The students interacted with recovering addicts and conveyed to them that healing is a journey worth taking. They also emphasized the importance of patience, compassion, hope, supporting oneself and others, self-motivation to heal and grow, and resilience in the journey of their recovery. Throughout the visit, students had the opportunity to engage in discussions with counselors and therapists, gaining firsthand knowledge of the therapeutic techniques employed in addiction recovery. They observed group therapy sessions, individual counseling sessions, and recreational activities designed to promote socialization and skill-building among patients.

Overall, the visit was a transformative learning experience for the psychology students, fostering empathy, awareness, and a deeper understanding of addiction and mental health care.

**Outcome of the Activity**

The students learn to initiate the counselling session with the drug addicts and provide them with the Individual Counselling Session and also interact with them in group and conduct Group Counselling session on the trigger management. This will help the students to gain confidence when they start working as a professional.

**Conclusion**

The hands-on experience at the Bolster Treatment and Rehabilitation Centre helped students build confidence and practical skills, preparing them for professional counselling roles.
