1. Approval of BA English Syllabus (NEP 2020):

 The faculty presented the revised BA English syllabus aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

 Prof. Gurupdesh Singh and Prof. Vivek Sachdeva reviewed the syllabus and provided their expert opinions.

The syllabus was discussed in detail, with inputs from all faculty members.

 The committee unanimously approved the BA English syllabus by suggesting modifications to enhance the curriculum.

2. Approval of MA English Syllabus (CBCS):

 The faculty presented the revised MA English syllabus based on the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).

Prof. Gurupdesh Singh and Prof. Vivek Sachdeva reviewed the syllabus and provided

their expert opinions.

- The syllabus was discussed thoroughly, focusing on course outcomes, structure, and content.
- The committee approved the MA English syllabus with the inclusion of suggested electives to provide a broader range of options for students.

3. Multidisciplinary Course: ENH161 Professional Communication:

The course aims to enhance students' professional communication skills, integrating practical applications relevant across various disciplines.

The committee approved the course, emphasizing its importance in the current job market.

4. Ability Enhancement Courses:

- ENH111 Cambridge English I: The course focuses on foundational English language skills, using Cambridge resources.
- ENH112 Cambridge English II: A follow-up course, which builds on the skills learned in Cambridge English I.
- ENH151 Communication Skills: A course designed to improve students' overall communication abilities, incorporating various practical exercises.
- All three courses were reviewed, and the committee approved them, highlighting their significance in enhancing students' language proficiency and communication skills.

5. Suggestions on Job Opportunities and Employability:

- Mr. Vishal Verma, the industry expert, shared insights on current job market trends and potential career paths for English graduates.
- He emphasized the importance of skills like content writing, digital marketing, publishing, and teaching.
- The need for practical training and internships was highlighted to improve employability.
- The faculty discussed integrating more skill-based courses and workshops into the curriculum to prepare students for various career opportunities.

Conclusion:

- The meeting concluded with a consensus on the approved syllabi for both BA and MA English programs.
- The department will incorporate the suggestions to enhance the employability of graduates.
