At the onset of the meeting, Dr. Sudhir Kumar welcomed all the esteemed members of the board of studies (BOS), Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, DAV University, for their presence at the meeting. Dr. Sudhir then proceeded with the agenda for the meeting.

Members discussed and deliberated on various items of the agenda. The board approved followings:

1.	Preparation of scheme and syllabi-for B. Pharmacy 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> Semester, B. Pharmacy Lateral entry & D. Pharmacy 2 <sup>nd</sup> Year.	<ul> <li>a) The unanimous decision was made to adopt the regulations, scheme, and syllabi exactly as prescribed by PCI, New Delhi.</li> <li>b) Bridge course for lateral entry (LEET) students, containing the following subjects:</li> <li>Communication skills - 3 Credits (Theory and Practical).</li> <li>Computer Application in Pharmacy - 4 Credits (Theory &amp; Practical).</li> </ul>
		c) It was decided to incorporate industrial training into the curriculum. Students will undergo

		industrial training during the session breaks following the 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> semesters. They must submit a training report, attendance record, and training certificate for the award of the marks. Their assessment will be done in 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 5 <sup>th</sup> semester for Pharmaceutics/Chemistry practical subjects.
2.	Introduction of new Programme: - Ph.D. in Pharmaceutical Sciences.	The start of the PhD program in Pharmaceutical Sciences was unanimously approved by all committee members.
3.	Approval of Academic Calendar as per PCI norms.	The committee members approved academic calendar, ensuring compliance with the required number of working days as recommended by the PCI.
4.	Change of B. Pharmacy and D. Pharmacy course codes as per PCI norms.	It was decided that the course codes for both the B.Pharm and D.Pharm programs will be updated as per with PCI regulations.
5.	Suggestions for methodologies in innovative teaching techniques.	Use of ICT tools in classrooms/ lectures. More emphasis to be paid on tutorials, presentations and group discussion for overall development of students.
6.	Suggestions regarding coordination of extension and academic activities.	Extension activities: It was unanimously decided to instill social values and responsibilities in both faculty members and students, fostering the holistic development of society. This will be achieved by organizing social service events, one-day health camps, field tours, and other activities to nurture a strong sense of social responsibility in students.
		Academic activities:  a) Academic activities such as guest lectures and seminars will be organized to enhance student's knowledge and engagement.
		b) Efforts will be made for collaborating with distinguished institutions, universities, hospitals, and industries. We will prioritize establishing academic and industrial Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) for student's workshops and training activities.

7. Design of skill development certificate course:
 'Pharmaceutical Sales
 Representative Certification
 Programme'.

The introduction of the certificate course "Pharmaceutical Sales Representative" received unanimous approval from all committee members. The program's syllabus will be specifically designed to offer comprehensive training for students who aim to become skilled pharmaceutical sales representatives.

# Following suggestion were given by the committee members:

- a) Sh. Navdeep Chawla advised to designate one week as Industry Week in the department, during which seminars / workshops will be conducted by the industry experts. He advised for the Appointment of 'professor of practice' to provide pharmacy students with industry-oriented, practical knowledge through seminars/workshops.
- b) Dr. R.K. Narang suggested to hold an environment safety programme in the nearby villages adopted by DAV University. Students will conduct visits to raise awareness about the safe use of pesticides and may also perform soil contamination testing during these visits.
- c) Dr. Pradeep Mattu proposed that D.Pharm students should receive training in and ambulance services and medical devices to give them hands-on, real-world experience in emergency situations.
- d) Dr. Permender Rathee advised to teach adverse drug reactions in 1<sup>st</sup> year of B.Pharm & D.Pharm course so that students can raise awareness in society about medication misuse and the dangers of self-medication. Students can learn reporting of Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs), which plays a critical role, especially in a country like India. This knowledge supports regulatory decision-making, enhances educational efforts, and contributes to global health improvements.

All these suggestions were approved by committee.

The meeting was concluded with the vote of thanks to the chair.
