

DIRECTIONS AND EXAMPLES

Read the following directions and examples carefully when the examiner reads them aloud

The Interest Record consists of a number of pairs like the one given below. Each activity in a pair is marked A, B, C, D, E, F, or G.

Example :

- (D) Collect flowers and leaves
- (C) Collect insects

Read over the two activities in each group. Decide which ONE of the two activities you like more. On the Record Sheet are numbers corresponding to the numbers of the pairs of activities (from 1 to 168) and boxes against each number in columns marked A, B, C, D, E, F, and G. For each liked activity put a cross in the box in the proper column. The person answering the above example likes activity D, therefore a cross has been put in box below column D on the record sheet against the Example.

In some cases you may like both the activities in a pair and in other cases you may dislike both. If you like both the activities in a pair then choose the one you like more ; and if you dislike both then you choose the one you dislike less. You must choose one alternative out of each pair and leave no pair unmarked.

The pairs of statements on the following pages are similar to the example given above. Record your responses for each of them on the record sheet. Be sure you are marking for the same item on the record sheet as you are reading in the booklet.

There is no time limit but do not spend much time in pondering over any pair. Return the booklet and record sheet as soon as you have completed the work.
