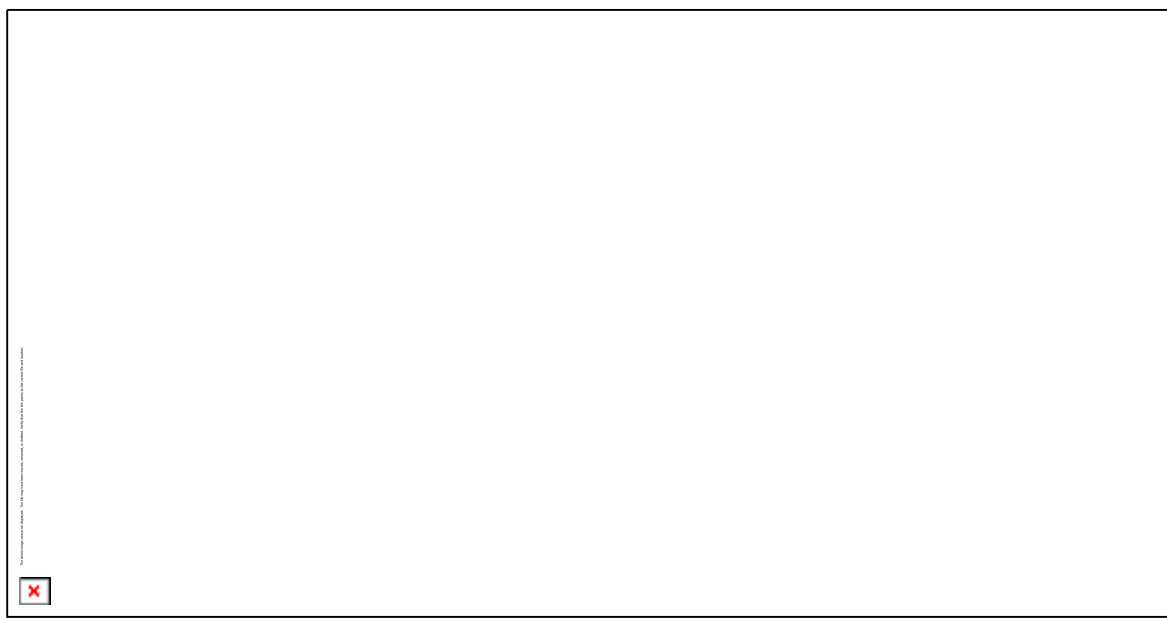
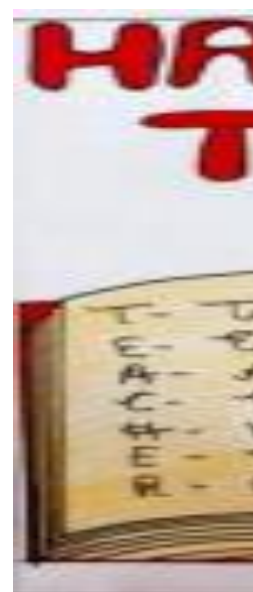

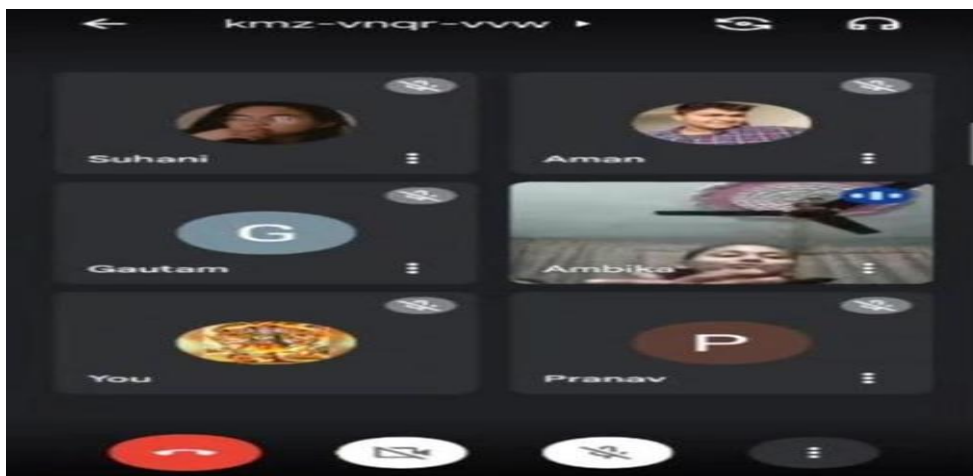
**Report :**
