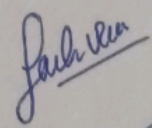
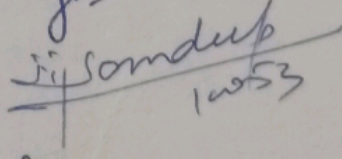
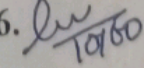
It was discussed and unanimously resolved to approve the proposed schemes and syllabi for the Doctor of Philosophy for the Batch 2021-22

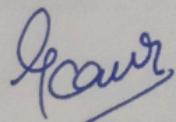
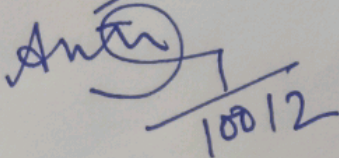
It was discussed and unanimously resolved to approve the proposed schemes and syllabi for the following programs of Batch 2021

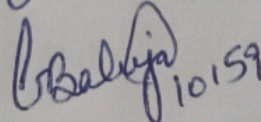
- a) Bachelor of Commerce
