ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DEAN (STUDENT WELFARE):

To promote and safeguard the welfare, interests, and overall development of students within the institution.

Key Aspects of the role:

1. Student Support and Welfare

- Address student grievances related to academic, social, or personal issues.
- Ensure mental health and counseling services are available.

2. Holistic Development:

- Promote cultural, sports, and recreational activities.
- Coordinate student clubs, societies, and associations.
- Organize annual fests, competitions, and talent shows.

3. Discipline and Conduct

- Oversee student discipline and help enforce codes of conduct.
- Resolve conflicts and disputes among students or between students and staff.
- Ensure a safe, respectful, and inclusive environment.

4. Accommodation and Campus Life

- Monitor hostels, dining services, and student housing conditions.

6. Career and Personal Development

- Support career counseling and skill development initiatives.

7. Emergency and Crisis Management
