

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF DEAN (RESEARCH)

The Dean (Research) shall be responsible for the strategic planning, development, promotion, and implementation of research initiatives across the University. The core responsibilities include:

1. Policy Development and Implementation

- Formulate, review, and implement comprehensive research policies and procedures to strengthen the research ecosystem within the University.
- Ensure alignment of research practices with national and international standards, funding agency guidelines, and ethical norms.

2. Promotion of Interdisciplinary and Transdisciplinary Research

- Foster a collaborative research culture by encouraging interdepartmental, interdisciplinary, and transdisciplinary research programs.
- Organize workshops, seminars, and brainstorming sessions to facilitate cross-disciplinary research dialogue.

3. Research Outputs and Intellectual Property

- Facilitate and monitor the registration and documentation of research publications in high-impact peer-reviewed journals.
- Promote innovation by supporting the filing of patents and other intellectual property rights (IPR).
- Maintain a central repository/database of faculty research contributions.

4. International Research Collaboration

- Promote and coordinate international research collaborations, joint projects, and MoUs with reputed foreign institutions.
- Support faculty and researchers in applying for international grants and exchange programs.

5. Research Funding and Grant Management

- Identify funding opportunities and guide faculty in preparing and submitting competitive research proposals.
- Oversee proper utilization, monitoring, and reporting of internal and external research grants.
- Liaise with funding agencies and ensure compliance with reporting requirements.

6. PhD Program Oversight

- Act as the Incharge for the University's PhD programs, ensuring adherence to academic and administrative regulations.
- Monitor the progress of doctoral scholars, coordinate with supervisors, and ensure timely submission of progress reports, theses, and other academic requirements.
- Facilitate PhD coursework, pre-submission seminars, and viva-voce examinations in accordance with University and UGC guidelines.

7. Capacity Building and Mentorship

- Encourage faculty development in research through training programs, proposal-writing workshops, and mentoring.
- Support early-career researchers and doctoral students in establishing their research careers.

8. Reporting and Compliance

- Prepare periodic reports on the University's research output, funding status, collaborations, and impact for submission to statutory bodies and accreditation agencies.
- Ensure all research activities comply with institutional, legal, and ethical standards.
