

Report:

The seminar titled "Child Abuse in the Media: Impact, Representation, and Responsibility" was organized for students on 8th September 2020 to raise awareness about the critical issue of child abuse and its portrayal in media. Experts discussed the harmful effects of sensationalized media coverage on both survivors and society. Emphasis was placed on how media representations can sometimes perpetuate stereotypes, distort facts, or desensitize audiences to the severity of abuse. Students were actively engaged through case studies and discussions, which explored how responsible reporting can aid in prevention and support for victims. The seminar also highlighted the ethical responsibilities of media outlets in protecting the dignity and privacy of child victims. The event concluded with a call to action for future journalists and media creators to prioritize sensitivity and accuracy when covering such issues. Overall, the seminar succeeded in promoting a deeper understanding of the media's role in shaping public perception of child abuse.


