Dr. Suresh Kumar Khurana, Associate Professor and HoD, P.G Department of Economics, DAV College Jalandhar, was the resource person for the session. Mr. Vinod, Assistant Professor, Department of CBME welcomed the guest speaker.



Dr. Khurana described in detail the effect of Covid pandemic on the Indian economy. A comparison of main sectors of economy namely petroleum, coal, electricity etc. was made based on pre-covid, during and after covid-19 situation. He explained how the demand patterns have changed all together. Consumer buying behavior has been greatly influenced by the current




