On May 21, 2020, the Department of Commerce and Business Management at DAV University hosted a successful webinar. The session featured Dr. Nripendra Singh, Professor of Marketing at Clarion University of Pennsylvania, as the keynote speaker. Dr. Singh presented his developed Hybrid High-Impact Pedagogy in Management Education, designed to enhance student learning and foster an entrepreneurial ecosystem. Dr. Singh's presentation detailed the components of his pedagogy, which integrates service-learning, study abroad, internships, and undergraduate research. He provided insights into the implementation of this pedagogy, including the rubric for presentations, measurement tools for assessing impact, and details on syllabus and grading.
